

Sally Treanor is a Buffalo native who received early training in oils from portraitist George Palmer and figurative artist Grace McKendry. Since 1975, her professional commitment has been to transparent watercolor. She has studied with many eminent watercolorists over the years and has traveled to master classes throughout the United States and abroad to China, Italy, Switzerland, Greece and England. Sally has lived all over the United States, moving with her family for twenty years before returning to Buffalo in 1987. The opportunity to immerse in landscapes as varied as Hawaii, the Hudson Valley, and the Deep South has informed her landscape painting which she will be demonstrating.

An Aquarellist, Treanor employs traditional transparent watercolor techniques using no opaque white or black pigments. Works are done with great attention to color in a limited palette based on triads. She has a passion for teaching, taking great joy in the progress of her students. She takes care to thoroughly introduce her students to the materials, techniques, and vocabulary of watercolor and art in general.
