

May was a pretty amazing month for NFWS. St. Louis artist Carol Carter conducted our workshop. True to her reputation, Carol managed to flip some of our preconceived notions on their heads. She paints in "cells" using limited palettes of three to six colors. The cells effectively create rhythms in her paintings, alternating cool and warm, dark and light, images emerging from unexpected patterns. She also introduced us to some new pigments, such as Shadow Violet that are mighty tricky. Still mulling all the information to see where it will affect change in my own work.

It was my privilege to watch Carol Carter judging our Spring Exhibition at the Carnegie Art Center. It was so interesting to hear the criteria that she uses for selecting winners and was surprised that, besides the usual need for excellence in execution, she looks for an emotional connection between artist and subject. Carol affirmed in her comments her admiration for the quality of the Exhibit. She was so impressed that she added five additional "Judge's Choice" Awards.

In June, we welcome back, for the 6th year, our **Show Your Art Show** when you bring in your paintings to share with the group.
