

# LINDA FRAYNE KEMP

A full time artist, **Linda Frayne Kemp** frequently instructs and lectures at national symposiums and watercolour workshops throughout Canada, The United States and The United Kingdom. She was the recipient of the 2005 Woman of Distinction Award for Arts and Culture and in 2008 received the AJ Casson Medal for Outstanding Achievement in Watercolour, the top award for the Canadian Society of Painters in Watercolour National Juried Exhibition.

Linda is internationally recognized for her unique contemporary watercolours and innovative use of negative painting. She is the author of two books: Watercolor Painting Outside the Lines - A Positive Approach to Negative Painting and Simplifying Design and Color For Artists - Positive Results Using Negative Painting Techniques (North Light pub.) and four instructional DVDs. Kemp is an elected member of the Canadian Society of Painters in Watercolour, The Ontario Society of Artists and The Society of Canadian Artists and was given honorary membership in the Society for all Artists (UK). This artist is profiled in Canadian Who's Who, Who's Who of Canadian Women, The Dictionary of International Biography, The 20th Anniversary Edition of Trivial Pursuit and 2000 Outstanding Intellectuals of the 21st Century. Indeed, if you came to the meeting (just short of 100 painters in attendance), you left filled with great enthusiasm to charge into working on that tricky, elusive Yupo. Dynamo Eileen Sudzina demystified Yupo with an amazing demonstration that was generously informative and exciting. She included many hints and clues to success on this different surface and then went on to demonstrate how to pull them off. Among my biggest take-aways was her liberal use of masking fluid to define important areas of her drawing. And it wasn't until the end of the painting, when she removed the masking fluid, that I understood how important it was in the final pulling together of what seemed to be disparate elements while she was applying paint. You had to be there.

Ontario artist Linda Frayne Kemp (www.lindakemp.com), our fall workshop artist, will demonstrate for our October members meeting. Linda has an international reputation as an expert in negative painting, an approach that I find very exciting for its unique design opportunities. I also find it exciting to reverse my thought processes to pull it off. I'm told that artists, as a group, are among the most long-lived people worldwide because their brains are so much engaged across so many disciplines. Negative painting is my key to longevity. See you in 2030. In the meanwhile, make plans to come see Linda Kemp's demo at Burchfield Penney Art Center, October 19 on the Buffalo State Campus, Elmwood Avenue.
