



Artist statement:

I have been involved with the arts for many years, probably ever since I could pick up a pencil and draw. While still very young I was able to commute to Buffalo from my home in Eden to attend weekly class studying under Anthony Sisti and also attending classes at the Albright Knox. I graduated from Eden Senior High School and went on to Daemen College where I studied Art History with an emphasis on human figure drawing and painting. My focus was always on artistic achievement especially in relationship to natural beauty and landscape. I have found that working with dry brush watercolor has been the perfect medium to express my artistic vision. There is a constant building up or weaving of texture and color that gives way to my heightened realism. Other facets of expression of creativity range from oil as well as the need for my creation of mixed media collage & abstract themes.
