Nancy Lane is a professional artist from Canandaigua, NY. She often paints wet-in-wet, taking advantage of the exciting mixing that watercolor paint does on a wet sheet, unlike any other medium. Nancy does a fair amount of plein air painting, and while painting a landscape demonstration, she will talk about how to create a sense of light within the scene. Nancy is a popular watercolor instructor at Pat Rini Rohrer gallery in Canandaigua, as well as at her home studio. She also teaches drawing, and enjoys painting portraits from life in oil and watercolor. Her favorite subjects are figures in the landscape. She now works full time as a painter after a 30-year career as a picture book illustrator working in watercolor. She'll bring a large assortment of her paintings for you to look at up close. FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear NFWS friends:

Our February artist was Mary Hardegen, longtime member and supporter of NFWS, including serving as president for four years and constant shepherding of those selfless folks who handle setup and breakdown for the meetings. Mary's presentation, like herself, was terrifically practical and helpful. She started out with a description of the resource (her photo taken in Acadia National Park in Maine) and her attachment to the place after many visits. She first wet the paints that she had selected to use (a triadic combination of a warm and cool red, warm and cool blue, and warm and cool yellow for a total of six pigments.) She developed her beautifully light-filled painting with a combination of washes and loaded-brush strokes, the latter done with carefully controlled water and little rinsing between adding paint to her brush. As she progressed through the painting, her technique kept values strong and contrasts between warm and cool exciting to the eye. She closed her demonstration by showing four other versions of the same scene, each one different, fresh, and emphasizing different areas/objects. Wonderful work, Mary. Thank you so much. And once again, our new projection equipment was ably handled by Pete Snyder, allowing those in back good views of Mary's technique.

Coming up in March will be **Nancy Lane**, a Canandaigua artist who spent her early career as a book illustrator. Once again, **Mike Killelea** has found a new-to-us artist with fresh insights. We are so privileged to be able to expand our own knowledge base of technique and regional artists.

And always enhancing our meetings are our hosts. January hosts were Mary Jo Ketchum and Sandy Ludwig and February hosts were Deb Meier and Phyllis Vasbinder. We thank them for their generosity. If you would like to assist in March or April, please call Deb (316-1029) to volunteer.
