BILL MANCUSO

Bill Mancuso first came to painting as a kid with a local artist, Rose DiCarlo, who taught out of her home and who had us out on the street drawing and painting whenever she could. His formal training includes a BFA from SUNY College of Brockport in drawing and painting and an MFA in drawing and painting from the University of Buffalo Since 1998, Bill has taught at Ohio Northern University in the flatlands of Ada, Ohio.

Bill's Artist Statement:

For myself, drawing and painting is about seeing interconnectedness. By attempting to see, by participating in the process of seeing, I try to be conscious and pay attention. Drawing and painting, for me, is a way to create a trail of my attention to the moment, of being here now. When I consider what Gandhi said when asked about his message, "my life is my message", perhaps the trail one leaves in art and life is not only our message, but the ultimate form of art?



FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear NFWS friends:

Our March demonstrator was **Nancy Lane**, a Canandaigua artist who spent her early career as a book illustrator. She has been teaching all levels of watercolor for years and is obviously very comfortable sharing her expertise while she paints.

She introduced her subject with a photo of a favorite site in the Finger Lakes (she is an avid Plein Air painter) of which she had done two nicely conceived smaller studies. Her half-sheet demo featured a dramatic sky with fingers of light emerging through the clouds, hitting both shoreline and lake surface. She deftly explained how she decided her compositional elements, using the strong light as it zigzagged through the clouds and bounced off land and water. Her additions of color into the previously wetted sky allowed her to work through a chosen palette of about five colors that she repeated throughout the painting, providing for excellent color harmony. She developed the painting top to bottom, farthest to nearest, systematically adhering to her preselected compositional plan and pigments. The finished work had such a strong sense of place and time of day. One of Nancy's comments that had such a ring of truth was that, because she has worked for years on location in her region, she has absorbed the feeling, colors, flora, and natural shapes to such an extent that she is comfortable working without photo resources. Nice place to be!

Coming to us in April is Ohio artist, **Bill Mancuso**, who paints whenever he can,
wherever he might be, whatever subject matter
presents itself. What a wonderful way to be an
artist. I wonder if...
