Sandy Ludwig: I have always felt that critiques are a way of opening up dialogue or conversations about our art work. We can all remember having heard something during a conversation/critique about our art or that of others that has stayed with us. And sometimes we are able take advantage of someone else's knowledge. I do believe that the word critique sometimes carries a negative connotation. Approached in a positive manner it can be a helpful and welcome tool.
