Roger DeMuth is an award-winning designer, illustrator, photographer and gardener who lives in Cazenovia. Professor of Illustration at Syracuse University from 1979-2014, he has been the Creative Director of DeMuth Design since 1970. Roger was head of the Syracuse University Illustration Program 1998-2000, Co-coordinator of the ISDP-MFA, Master's Degree in Illustration 1993-1996 and organized the NYC Lubin House Senior Class Portfolio Open House for 20+ years. His work has appeared in numerous exhibitions, including the Society of Illustrators in NYC and Los Angeles. His watercolors were featured in the Sept. 2017 issue of The Artist's Magazine. Artist Statement: I always wanted to be an artist, and I found out along the way that the making of the art was the best part. It still doesn't matter to me which direction I choose. I can be just as happy working with watercolors as I am painting with oil paints or working in clay or digging in the gardens. I get up early in the morning & go right to work in the studio. I always start out with a sketch, revise it, do more idea sketches and think about the object from every angle before I begin making anything. This method has served me well. If I am not making something, I am miserable.
