# **GLENN BLUE**

October Workshop Artist

Glenn E. Blue grew up in a family of artists in the suburbs of Philadelphia, PA. His parents were art teachers at local schools. He has trained in fine arts since childhood and by his teenage years Glenn was selling paintings professionally and had shown in countless local, regional, national and international shows. He has travelled to numerous places in Europe painting and collecting art. He has taken many workshops and private lessons over the years. Glenn was in the US Navy from 1984 to 1988, and then entered the Pennsylvania State Police. For years he was assigned to the Violent Felony Fugitive Task Force in Philadelphia and served his last few years as a supervisor in Criminal Investigations. He spent many days rushing home from crime scenes to get to his studio or art opening. He is now retired from the State Police to continue his pursuit of art.

Glenn paints loose, glowing, impressionistic, yet representational watercolors on his many plein air painting trips as well in his studio. He attempts to artistically represent his subjects' atmosphere, without adding every detail. He is considered one of the region's best snow scene watercolorists. Glenn has been represented by the Chadds Ford Gallery and the Barbara Moore Gallery in the Brandywine area of Pennsylvania for many years.
