Judith's degree is in Art Education. She has taught art in public and private schools in Ohio, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts and New York. She has also taught workshops at Cazenovia College, The Everson Museum, The Schweinfurth Memorial Art Gallery and for numerous art guilds in the Syracuse area.

Watercolor is her first love, although she devotes a large portion of her creative time to drawing and has made occasional forays into acrylics, printmaking and collage. Her subject matter and style are eclectic, ranging from representational to abstract and geometric. More recently, she has been enjoying the challenges of combining abstraction of natural forms with geometric shapes – especially in the series of paintings she entitles "Fractured Flora." The painting, Trillium, pictured above is an example of this genre. Judy will be demonstrating this method on Yupo at the NFWS Members Meeting on April 20.

Judith agrees with the painter, Delacroix that, "The first merit of a painting is to be a feast for the eye." and that is what she hopes to achieve in her work.
