Mary Whyte is an American figurative artist known internationally for her watercolors of contemporary people. Her works are in private, corporate, university and public collections nationwide. The author of seven books, Whyte's work has also been featured in many international publications. She is the recipient of numerous awards including the Portrait Society of America's Gold Medal and the South Carolina Governor's Award for the Arts, the state's highest honor in the arts. September 2022 Whyte received the Annie Oakley Society Award for her role as a leader in the artistic community and inspirational work through the Patriot Art Foundation which Whyte founded as a means to honor and inspire veterans through the arts. Whyte's exhibition of fifty large-scale watercolors called We The People: Portraits of Veterans in America is on view at the National Museum of the United States Army near Washington, DC, through July 14, 2023. There is also a book by the same name.
