Michael Ridge finds inspiration in his rural surroundings. Similarities between the central Pennsylvania landscape of his childhood, and the Vermont landscape where he now resides with his wife and child form a bridge for Michael between his past and present. He is drawn to the imprint humans leave on nature, from the working farm, to abandoned equipment left to rust. Realism is important in his work, and by striking a balance between control in details and the spontaneity and transparency inherent in watercolor, Michael has found a way to share the emotional connection he feels to the landscape

After graduating from Syracuse University with a BFA in sculpture, Michael worked as a mold technician at the NY based prototyping company, Art Asylum. In 2003, Michael moved to Vermont and spent 13 years as lead sculptor at Advanced Animations.

In 2016 Michael turned his focus full time to fine art, including watercolor painting and sculpture. He has been accepted in local, national, and international juried watercolor shows and has won numerous prestigious awards. His work has been published in The Artists's and Watercolor Artist's magazines and SPLASH. He has signature membership in the New England and Vermont Watercolor Societies.
