Barbara Fox is an accomplished artist whose paintings and drawings have garnered numerous awards and been included in distinguished collections. Her work is characterized by strong values and vibrant, intense colors, capturing a wide range of subjects with exceptional precision.

Paintings have been featured in solo and group exhibitions in museums and galleries throughout the United States, including the Phillips Museum of Art in Lancaster, PA; the Millicent Rogers Museum in Taos, New Mexico; the Arnot Art Museum in Elmira, NY; and the European Museum of Modern Art in Barcelona, Spain.

Fox's work has been published in 5 editions of the watercolor publication *Splash: The Best of Watercolor Painting*, and has been a featured artist in the leading national art magazines *American Artist* and *Watercolor Magic*. Fox leads watercolor workshops around the country, teaching her method of layering washes and painting details.

Barbara Fox also worked in illustration, including clients American Greetings, Timex Inc, Disney, and the United States Mint. From 2007 to 2020, 23 of her designs were minted as coins and medals. Currently, portrait work has led to commissioned portraits of retired judges for the Allegany County and Cattaraugus County Courthouses.
